





### Scope of Work-Carriageway Stabilization Comstock Cemetery Foundation Carriageway Stabilization

The historic landscape which we have worked with for 21 years is not the same as working with a structure. Rarely, if ever, can we provide a fixed costs for a project as it is impacted by various factors:

- Bedrock, soil composition
- Burials-avoidance of
- Working around public visitors
- Unforeseen underground obstacles
- Unearthing of artifacts

### **Providing Estimates**

We ask contractors to provide a range of costs and we arrange our finances and sponsors to cover the high end of that range should any issue prevent the contractor from keeping the estimate. #### Monitor

We have trained monitors. For this project, Cal Dillon, a trained and experienced monitor will head this effort.

Cost: \$645.00 (paid by CCF).

### Landscape Architect

Our landscape architect, designer of our master plan, will be available via zoom during the project for on-site consultation and problem resolution.

Cost: \$2,300 (paid by CCF).

### Backhoe and Operator: Greg Hess, Senior

- Grade 16 degrees N, main carriageway to realign the road edge. This is approximately 525 feet on the north-east section of the carriageway.
- Install sand base and gravel on road edge for 90-95' to provide additional drainage support on the downward side of the road edge.
- Trench profile established for French Drain installation for approximately 60'.

### Landscape Team, project manager, Noe Alcala, El Patio Landscaping

- Complete hand dig of the French Drain trench. Lay sand, and install the French Drain for 60'.
- The drain will be directed in accordance with our master plan and flow into a natural gully drainage that doesn't impact any cultural features and its bedrock in nature.

Proclamation by Storey County, Nevada

WHEREAS, many Storey County residents may not be informed about radon, yet for the safety and health of their families, need to know that radon is a colorless, odorless, naturally occurring radioactive gas and is the leading cause of lung cancer among nonsmokers; the second leading cause of lung cancer in smokers and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency estimates 21,000 people in the U.S. die each year from lung cancer caused by indoor radon exposure; and radon kills more people than secondhand smoke, drunk driving, falls in the home, drowning, or home fires; and

**WHEREAS**, a home may have elevated levels of radon, even if neighboring homes do not; and living in a home with an average radon level of 4 picocuries per liter of air poses a similar risk of developing lung cancer as smoking half a pack of cigarettes a day; and

WHEREAS, testing is the only way to know if a home has an elevated radon level, and testing is easy and inexpensive, and when identified, homes can be fixed; and

# Contract for Lobbyist Services Between Storey County and Silver State Government Relations

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by and between Silver State Government Relations, 204 N. Minnesota Street Carson City NV 89703, legislative and government relations lobbyists, together with its successors and assigns, as an independent contractor, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor" and Storey County, Nevada, hereinafter referred to as "ORGANIZATION."

Whereas ORGANIZATION is authorized to enter into Contracts with Independent Contractors.

Whereas it is both necessary and in the best interests of ORGANIZATION to enter into the Contract.

Now therefore, in consideration of the aforesaid promises, the parties mutually agree as follow:

- 1. <u>DEFINITIONS</u>. "ORGANIZATION" means Storey County, Nevada, and is organized under the laws of the State of Nevada.
- 2. CONTRACT TERM. This contract shall be effective from June 15, 2021, to January 5, 2022, January 6, 2022, through June 30, 2022, unless sooner terminated by either party as specified in paragraph eight (8).
- 3. <u>NOTICE</u>. All notices or other communications required or permitted to be given under the Contract shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been duly given if delivered personally in hand, by telephonic facsimile with simultaneous regular mail, or mailed certified mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid on the date posted, and addressed to the other party at the address specified above.
- 4. <u>INCORPORATED DOCUMENTS</u>. The parties agree that this Contract, inclusive of the following attachments, specifically describes the scope of work. This Contract incorporates the following attachments in descending order of constructive precedence:

ATTACHMENT A: Scope of Work

- 5. <u>COMPENSATION</u> for services rendered Contractor shall receive the following compensation:
  - a. \$4,000 per month commencing <u>January 06, 2022</u>. July 1, 2021, with \$2,000 additional applied to June 15 June 30, 2021. Contract continuance and payment subject to approval by the Board of Storey County Commissioners.
  - b. If parties agree to extend the contract related to additional work on the subject <u>legislative matters</u> at hand [Innovation Zones and related matters], contract term may be extended by mutual agreement <u>with approval by the Board of Storey County Commissioners</u>.
- 6. <u>ASSENT</u>. The parties agree that the terms and conditions listed on incorporated attachments of this Contract are also specifically a part of this Contract and are limited only by their respective order of precedence and any limitations specified.

### 7. INSPECTION & AUDIT.

- a. <u>Books and Records</u>. Contractor agrees to keep and maintain true and complete records, contracts, books, and documents as are necessary to fully disclose to ORGANIZATION, or their authorized representatives, upon audits or reviews, sufficient information to determine compliance with all state and federal regulations and statutes.
- b. <u>Inspection and Audit</u>. Contractor agrees that the relevant books, records (written, electronic, computer related or otherwise), including, without limitation, relevant accounting procedures and practices of Contractor or its subcontractors, financial statements and supporting documentations, and documentation related to the work product shall be subject, at any reasonable time, to inspection, examination, review, audit, and copying at any office or location of Contractor where such records may be found, with or without notice by an auditor.

### 8. CONTRACT TERMINATION.

- c. <u>Termination Without Cause</u>. Any discretionary or vested right of renewal notwithstanding, this Contract may be terminated upon written notice by mutual consent of both parties, or unilaterally by either party without cause.
- d. <u>Cause Termination for Default or Breach</u>. A default or breach may be declared with or without termination. This Contract may be terminated by either party upon written notice of default or breach to the other party as follows:
  - i. If Contractor fails to provide or satisfactorily perform any of the conditions, work, deliverables, goods, or services called for by this Contract within the time requirements specified in this Contract or within any granted extension of those time requirements; or
  - ii. If any state, county, city or federal license, authorization, waiver, permit, qualification or certification required by statute, ordinance, law, or regulation to be held by Contractor to provide the goods or services required by this Contract is for any reason denied, revoked, debarred, excluded, terminated, suspended, lapsed, or not renewed; or

- iii. If Contractor becomes insolvent, subject to receivership, or becomes voluntarily or involuntarily subject to the jurisdiction of the bankruptcy court; or
- iv. If ORGANIZATION materially breaches any material duty under this Contract and any such breach impairs Contractor's ability to perform.
- b. <u>Time to Correct</u>. Termination upon a declared default or breach may be exercised only after service of formal written notice as specified in paragraph three (3), and the subsequent failure of the defaulting party within fifteen (15) calendar days of receipt of that notice to provide evidence, satisfactory to the aggrieved party, showing that the declared default or breach has been corrected.
- c. <u>Winding Up Affairs Upon Termination</u>. In the event of termination of this Contract for any reason, the parties agree that the provisions of this paragraph survive termination:
  - i. The parties shall account for and properly present to each other all claims for fees and expenses and pay those which are undisputed and otherwise not subject to set off under this Contract. Neither party may withhold performance of winding up provisions solely based on nonpayment of fees or expenses accrued up to the time of termination:
    - ii. Contractor shall satisfactorily complete work in progress at the agreed rate (or a pro rata basis if necessary) if so requested by ORGANIZATION;
    - iii. Contractor shall execute any documents and take any actions necessary to effectuate an assignment of this Contract if so requested by ORGANIZATION;
  - iv. Contractor shall preserve, protect and promptly deliver into ORGANIZATION possession all proprietary information.
- 9. <u>ASSIGNMENT AND BINDING EFFECT</u>. This Agreement shall be binding on and shall inure to the benefit of the respective successors and assigns of the Contractor and ORGANIZATION subject to the rights of the parties to terminate said Agreement as provided herein, but no assignment of this Agreement or any payments provided to be made hereunder shall be effective without written consent from the other parties.
- 10. <u>FORCE MAJEURE</u>. Neither party shall be deemed to be in violation of this Contract if it is prevented from performing any of its obligations hereunder due to strikes, failure of public transportation, civil or military authority, act of public enemy, accidents, fires, explosions, or acts of God, including without limitation, earthquakes, floods, winds, or storms. In such an event the intervening cause must not be through the fault of the party asserting such an excuse, and the excused party is obligated to promptly perform in accordance with the terms of the Contract after the intervening cause ceases.
- 11. <u>INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR</u>. Contractor is associated with ORGANIZATION only for the purposes and to the extent specified in this Contract, and in respect to

performance of the contracted services pursuant to this Contract, Contractor is and shall be an independent contractor and, subject only to the terms of this Contract, shall have the sole right to supervise, manage, operate, control, and direct performance of the details incident to its duties under this Contract. Nothing contained in this Contract shall be deemed or construed to create a partnership or joint venture, to create relationships of an employer-employee or principal-agent, or to otherwise create any liability for ORGANIZATION whatsoever with respect to the indebtedness, liabilities, and obligations of Contractor or any other party. Contractor shall be solely responsible for. and ORGANIZATION shall have no obligation with respect to: (1) withholding of income taxes, FICA or any other taxes or fees; (2) industrial insurance coverage; (3) participation in any group insurance plans available to employees of ORGANIZATION: (4) participation or contributions by either Contractor or ORGANIZATION to the Public Employees Retirement System; (5) accumulation of vacation leave or sick leave; or (6) unemployment compensation coverage provided by ORGANIZATION. Contractor shall indemnify and hold ORGANIZATION harmless from, and defend ORGANIZATION against, any and all losses, damages, claims, costs, penalties, liabilities, and expenses arising or incurred because of, incident to, or otherwise with respect to any such taxes or fees. Neither Contractor nor its employees, agents, or representatives shall be considered employees, agents, or representatives of ORGANIZATION. ORGANIZATION and contractor shall evaluate the nature of services and the term of the Contract negotiated in order to determine "independent contractor" status, and shall monitor the work relationship throughout the term of the Contract to ensure that the independent contractor relationship remains as such.

- 12. <u>COMPLIANCE WITH LEGAL OBLIGATIONS</u>. Contractor shall procure and maintain for the duration of this Contract any state, county, city or federal license, authorization, waiver, permit, qualification or certification required by statute, ordinance, law or regulation to be held by Contractor to provide the goods or services required by this Contract. Contractor will be responsible to pay all taxes, assessments, fees, premiums, permits, and licenses required by law.
- 13. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>. If any provision contained in this Contract is held to be unenforceable by a court of law or equity, this Contract shall be construed as if such provision did not exist and the non-enforceability of such provision shall not be held to render any other provision or provisions of the Contract unenforceable.
- 14. <u>ASSIGNMENT/DELEGATION</u>. To the extent that any assignment of any right under this Contract changes the duty of either party, increases the burden or risk involved, impairs the chances of obtaining the performance of this Contract, attempts to operate as a novation, or includes a waiver or abrogation of any defense to payment by ORGANIZATION, such offending portion of the assignment shall be void, and shall be a breach of this Contract. Contractor shall neither assign, transfer nor delegate any

rights, obligations or duties under this Contract without the prior written consent of ORGANIZATION.

15. <u>CONFIDENTIALITY</u>. Parties shall keep confidential all information, in whatever form, produced, prepared, observed or received by the receiving party pursuant to this Contract to the extent that such information is confidential by law or otherwise required by this Contract.

### 16. WARRANTIES.

- A. <u>General Warranty</u>. Contractor warrants that all services, deliverables, and/or work product under this Contract shall be completed in a workmanlike manner consistent with standards in the trade, profession, or industry; shall conform to or exceed the specifications set forth in the incorporated attachments; and shall be fit for ordinary use, of good quality, with no material defects.
- 17. ENTIRE CONTRACT AND MODIFICATION. This Contract and its integrated attachment(s) constitute the entire agreement of the parties and as such are intended to be the complete and exclusive statement of the promises, representations, negotiations, discussions, and other agreements that may have been made in connection with the subject matter hereof. Unless an integrated attachment to this Contract specifically displays a mutual intent to amend a particular part of this Contract, general conflicts in language between any such attachment and this Contract shall be construed consistent with the terms of this Contract. Unless otherwise expressly authorized by the terms of this Contract, no modification or amendment to this Contract shall be binding upon the parties unless the same is in writing and signed by the respective parties hereto.

- If running as a candidate of a major political party, have not, in violation of the provisions of NRS 293.176, changed the designation of your political party or political party affiliation on an official application to register to vote in any state since December 31st before the closing filing date for this election.

Candidates are required by law to submit various public financial reports including Contributions & Expenses, Financial Disclosure Statements and Ethics Reports pursuant to NRS 281 and 281A.
